

2019 FYBA Scholarship

The Farmington Youth Basketball Association (FYBA) has 2 scholarships available for \$500 that will be awarded to student athlete or manager; one for girls program and one for boys program.

Application Program Guidelines:

1. Applicant must be a graduating senior who is graduating from Farmington High School.
2. All decisions by FYBA on scholarship awards are final.
3. Recipients may be recognized at an awards ceremony and may be pictured in promotional materials.
4. Scholarship will be made payable to the recipient's educational institution when the FYBA has received proof of enrollment.
5. All applications must be submitted via Email by 6:00pm CST on May 15, 2018; applications received after this deadline will not be considered.
6. Criteria:
 - Must have participate in FHS girls or boys basketball program, this includes managers.
 - Demonstrated community involvement
 - Minimum GPA 3.0
 - Composite score that includes academics, activities, work, volunteering, and written essay

Application instructions (Only one application per student is allowed):

1. Print application.
2. SENIOR PHOTO: The application requires you to upload your senior photo to be used in the scholarship book in the event you are awarded a scholarship.
3. HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT: Applicant must submit a copy of their high school transcript (an unofficial transcript will suffice). You are allowed to use the transcript from your Campus Portal or similar record. You can copy and paste a print screen of the transcript to a Word document, or scan a printed copy to a PDF. Failure to submit the required essay may disqualify your application.
4. ANSWER all of the questions that apply to you.
5. LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION: The scholarships requires at least one letter of recommendation as detailed in the application. Letters must be attached to application.
6. DEADLINE: Your final application must be submitted by the deadline, 6:00pm CST on May 15, 2018. Any application submitted after this deadline will not be accepted, no exceptions
7. Scholarship Awards will be announced in early June.
